**Team Registration**

- Teams must provide one or more certified referee(s) in order to register. Each certified referee must work at least six youth and/or adult weekends during the season.
- Returning coed teams can register by having at least 10 players registered with the GLSA office by Aug. 3. If a returning team is not registered by Aug. 3, then the team’s spot is opened to new teams.
- Managers must bring the entire team minimum registrations to the Adult Director or register everyone online.
- If a team does not return for a new season, then the players formerly on that team can either join another team or will be placed on a waiting list.
- A team may have no more than 15 players on its roster.
- Roster changes can be made up to seven (7) business days before the start of the Adult season. Rosters are frozen for NTSSA registration at that time.
