

GLSA Adult Score Sheet Procedures

These rules apply to GLSA Adult league games.

Each manager will present a completed GLSA Score Sheet to the referees before each game. **Only official score sheets will be accepted.** Score sheets must include age group, team name, jersey color, manager's name, complete names of players with their jersey number, date, time of game, and field game is being played on. **The home team is always the first team listed on the schedule. For accurate scoring, please list the home team and visiting team.** Example attached.

At the end of the game, each manager must get his/her team score sheet from the referee. **Both managers** must deposit their score sheet after each game in one of the locked score sheet boxes located near each concession stand.

Points will be awarded as follows:

6 points for a win. 1 point per goal scored in the game with a max. of 3.

3 points for a tie. 1 point for a shutout (not allowing opponent to score).

0 points for a loss. A forfeit will be scored as a 3-0 win.

Eight (8) blank score sheets can be found in the packet that managers receive at the managers meeting and on the GLSA website. **They will no longer be available at the fields.**

Score sheets must be filled out completely before they are given to the referee. **Two (2) points will be deducted from the team's point total for score sheets not filled out completely. Five (5) points will be deducted from the team's point total if a score sheet is not presented to the referee. Two (2) points PER CARD will be deducted if player ID cards do not have jersey numbers on them.**

Score sheets and card write-ups will be collected after the last games on Sunday afternoons.

Score sheets may be dropped off at the GLSA office, emailed to office@longviewsoccer.com, or faxed to 903-759-2006 if not deposited at Lear Park. **A manager will have 48 hours after his/her game to turn in late score sheets. Two (2) points will be deducted from the team's point total after this time.**

Scores and standings will be posted on our website (www.longviewsoccer.com) and phone app by Wednesday, and at Lear Park by Friday.
