

GLSA Score Sheet Procedures

These rules apply to U-5 through U-8 age groups (both boys and girls).

Each coach will present a completed GLSA Score Sheet to the referee before each game. **Only official score sheets will be accepted.** Do not use tournament score sheets. Score sheets must include age group, team name, visiting team name, jersey color, coach and assistant coach names, complete names of players with their jersey number, date of game, time of game, and the field the game will be played on. An example is attached.

Scores are not kept for U5 through U8 games. The score sheets are used to verify that each rostered coach and assistant coach is visibly wearing his/her valid coach ID card. These coach ID cards show that the coach and assistant coach has an Approved background check. This is for the safety of our players.

At the end of the game the referee will deposit it at the referee room.

Eight (8) blank score sheets can be found in the packet that coaches receive at the team assignment meeting and on the website. **An emergency score sheet will be available at the referee room but will cost \$5.00 to obtain one. If a coach has to purchase two (2), then he/she will be suspended a game. Two games without a score sheet will result in a one-game suspension.**
