## Picture Taking Policy for Lear Park Soccer Complex

Due to the increase in the number of our players and field restriction changes made by the North Texas State Soccer Association (NTSSA), the Greater Longview Soccer Association (GLSA) feels like guidelines are needed for picture taking at the Lear Park Soccer Complex.

The NTSSA bylaws state that parents, non-playing players, and spectators should be located not less than 10 yards from outside the touchline, nor should they be closer than 10 yards from the goal line. Because of the limitations of the fields at Lear Park, GLSA has set up the following policy:

Parents, non-playing players, and spectators should be behind the designated areas for watching games. **No one is allowed behind the goal line. No one is allowed to watch a game from the sidewalk area.**

Photographers **will not** be allowed to take pictures from behind the goal line or the sidewalk.

No type of electronic camera may be placed on the goal, goal netting, behind the goal or the goal line.

The use of drones is prohibited; however, GLSA reserves the right to use a drone for advertising purposes.
