Policy on the proper use of Coaches I.D. card

1. A team may have up to three (3) coaches on a team roster. This would include a head coach and two (2) assistant coaches. An I.D. card will be issued for those with an approved background check and are rostered to a team.
2. Coaches I.D. cards must have a recent picture on them and be laminated. North Texas no longer requires them to be signed.
3. If for some reason ALL OF THE PEOPLE WITH A COACHES ID THAT ARE LISTED ON A ROSTER cannot be at a game, the following procedure must be followed:
 - The head coach will notify their commissioner with the name of the person who will fill in as coach for that game 48 hours in advance. In case of emergency, the 48-hour advance will be waived.
 - The commissioner will notify the office with the name of the replacement coach.
 - The person named will be issued a temporary coaches ID card that will be available at official's room before the game. The temporary ID card is to be returned immediately after the game or can be dropped in one of the score sheet boxes.
 - The head coach will fax or bring to the GLSA office a completed team score sheet. The office will make the completed score sheet available at the referee room before the game. 9U-19U head coaches must also provide the team's laminated picture player ID cards.
4. Just because a person is issued a coach's ID card does not give him/her the authority to coach another team if he/she is not on the roster. The ID card issued is only for the team to which he/she is rostered.
